Experience the awe-inspiring cliffs of Erris Head near Belmullet, and wander through the atmospheric ruins of Rosserk and Moyne Abbey, 15th-century Franciscan monasteries rich with history. You'll also immerse yourself in the charm of local towns like Killala and Lacken, each offering unique character and historical insights.

Join us for a transformative artistic experience in the heart of Ireland's stunning countryside. Let the dramatic landscapes and rich history of Ballycastle inspire your creativity and take your painting to new horizons!

Your artistic home for the week will be the Ballinglen Arts Foundation, located in the heart of Ballycastle. You'll have 24-hour access to their studio facilities, including your own dedicated workspace. Accommodations include private bedrooms in shared apartments or charming cottages, providing a cozy retreat after a day of creative exploration. Enjoy delicious daily lunches and dinners, with breakfast provisions available for you to prepare at your leisure.

Throughout the week, enriching field trips will take you to some of the most picturesque and historic sites in the region. Marvel at Downpatrick Head, with its dramatic sea stack, Dun Briste, and panoramic Atlantic views. Step back in time at the 6000-year-old Neolithic Ceide Fields, featuring



About Melanie Kozol:

Melanie Kozol, an American landscape painter, is known for her evocative paintings of the natural world. Kozol looks for archetypal formations in the environment to explore light, color, and atmosphere. Working from 'plein air' studies, photographic documentation, and memory, Kozol re-imagines the environment through the painting process. For the last 10 years, Kozol has focused her gaze on remote and ancient lands: Mayo County, Ireland; the Shetland Islands; the karst peaks in Southern China; and Waimea Canyon in Kaua'i. Drawing from prehistoric landscapes, she explores the spirit of the environment through light, color, and form. Her landscape

paintings and drawings are infused with memory and the experience of being in nature. Kozol has exhibited her work nationally for over four decades. She received her MFA from SVA and her BA from Connecticut College. Kozol's awards include an NEA Visual Arts Fellowship, an NYSS grant for drawing, and residencies at Skowhegan, Saltonstall, VCCA, the Clipperton Project and DNA. Her work is featured in numerous collections, including the OCC at the Department of the Treasury, Deutsche Bank, and the Bellagio Hotel. Kozol is a visiting assistant professor at Pratt Institute and a member of the faculty at the Gilda and Henry Block School of the Arts, 92NY.

Tour Details

Painting in Ireland Masterclass: From Landscape to Studio April 3 – 10, 2025

Fees:

- Single occupancy with ensuite bathroom: \$5,700
- Single occupancy with shared bathroom: \$5,200
- Double occupancy (per person) with ensuite bathroom: \$4,400

 Note: Please note that the Double Occupancy rooms include one double bed. If you choose this option, please be aware that we do not provide roommate matching services. You must list the name of the person you plan to share the room with, and they must also submit their own application indicating the same preference.

The fee for the trip includes the following:

- 6 days drawing and painting instruction daily
- 7 nights accommodations in a private room in a shared cottage or apartment at Ballinglen Arts Foundation supplied with towels, linens, and cooking utensils. A limited number of rooms with private baths (some ensuite) are available but not guaranteed.
- Private studio berth in the Ballinglen Arts Foundations studios with 24-hour access during your stay
- Basic supplies for breakfast daily (i.e. tea, coffee, cereal, bread, eggs, yogurt, fruit, juice, butter, etc.)
- Prepared lunch and dinner daily including one pub lunch and one box lunch during the planned excursions
- Access to the Ballinglen Arts Foundation studios, library, and kitchens
- Two-day trips to plein air painting locations, all transportation and admission fees included
- Roundtrip private airport shuttle from Dublin (DUB) to Ballinglen Arts Foundation

Cost of trip does not include

- Air transportation to Dublin, Ireland (DUB)
- Painting and drawing materials
- Alcoholic beverages and any other additional items purchased
- Trip Insurance (highly recommended)

Payment Schedule & Registration

A \$2,000 deposit is required by October 20, 2024 to reserve your place. The remaining balance of your trip fees are due by January 17, 2025. Please do not book any non-refundable transportation until the tour has been confirmed.

Tour Activity Level

You'll be on the go each day for most of the day on this tour. The group will travel to sites via private coach, or we'll be walking where you should expect uneven surfaces, stairs, and inclines. Participants can expect to be standing or walking for 1 - 2 hours at a time while on excursions and working outdoors in rugged surroundings for several hours. All tour start and end times will be announced at the beginning of the trip. Participants are responsible for arriving to the meeting locations on time. Your tour will begin and end with the included airport transfers.
