92NY Construction Project — FAQs

When will the work be completed?

This phase of 92NY's renovation will wrap up by late summer 2026. The lobby will be completed by August 2025.

How do I get to my program?

92nd Street Entrance:

- NURSERY SCHOOL:
- Use the 92nd Street entrance. Take the North Lobby elevators to the 6th floor
- EVENTS in Kaufmann Concert Hall and Weill Art Gallery
- Use the 92nd Street entrance, where a Box Office agent will be able to assist you.
- EVENTS in Buttenwieser Hall and Arnhold Studio
- Use the 92nd Street entrance and walk up one flight or take the North Lobby elevators to the second floor, where a Box Office agent will be able to assist you.

Lexington Ave and 91st St Entrance:

- STUDIO 92 AND JUNIOR GYM
- Use the Lexington Avenue entrance at 91st Street (South Building). Take the stairs or elevators to the Lower Level and use the hallway to access North Building Lower-Level locations.
- ALL OTHER PROGRAMS
- Use the Lexington Avenue entrance at 91st Street (South Building). Take the stairs or elevators to the third floor and access North Building programs via the 3rd Floor Walkway.

Where is the Himan Brown Senior Program?

From Mon, Jan 6, the Himan Brown Senior Program will be at the Redeemer Presbyterian Church, 150 E 91st St.

Where is the Program for Cognitive Strength and Ability?

From Mon, Jan 6, The Program for Cognitive Strength and Ability will be at the Altneu Synagogue, 107 E 70th St.

What are you building?

We are making transformative upgrades to our building, and we appreciate your patience and support while this work is underway! The results of this work will make 92NY more welcoming, sustaining and accessible for everyone.

Many areas of 92NY are being renovated. Some of the biggest changes include:

- A stunning new lobby with a spacious, double-height entrance that will seamlessly connect our buildings with modern architecture and top-notch security.
- In the North building, a grand staircase will lead to beautifully upgraded multipurpose spaces in the Lower Lobby.
- A fully modernized Art Center with state-of-the-art studios for Jewelry, Ceramics and Fine Arts programs
- And there are many more amazing changes to come!

How is this being paid for?

Who is your architect?

The internationally acclaimed architecture firm Beyer Blinder Belle designed all our renovations.

Will the work be noisy?

We are working to minimize noise but spaces adjacent to the construction may hear activity between 8 AM and 4 PM.

Where is the Box Office?

During events, our Mobile Box Office is located in the Hall of Mirrors which is accessible at the 92nd Street entrance.

Where is the Coat Check?

The location has not changed. Coat Check is at the far end of the Hall of Mirrors, accessible through the 92d Street entrance.

Where is the bar?

At some events where a bar is available it is located in the event area.

Where is the bathroom?

Bathrooms will be accessible as usual.

How do I get to the South Building from the North Building?

Take the stairs or elevator to the 2nd floor. Take the walkway to the 3rd floor of the South building. Or walk around outside to the Lexington Avenue entrance.

How do I get to the North Building from the South Building?

Take the stairs or elevator to the 3rd floor. Take the walkway to the 2nd floor of the North building. To access the North Building lower-level programs (Studio 92 and Junior Gym), take the stairs or elevator to the South Building lower level and use the hallway to access North Building lower-level locations.

Is there an incentive for May Center patrons to use the stairs?

As a May Center representative about our "Fit from the First Floor" initiative and learn how to win a 1-year May Center membership when you take the stairs!

Where is Afterschool pickup?

No change – Afterschool pickup will be from the location where you usually collect your child.
