PRIVATE LESSONS

PLEASE NOTE: All students must have their own instrument for private lessons and home practice. Please refer to our [Instrument Recommendations](#) document for information on renting or purchasing your instrument.

- Private lesson students are allotted **one** makeup lesson per semester if 24-hour notice is given. Additional missed lessons are forfeited and cannot be made up.
- Students are responsible for scheduling their makeup lesson directly with the teacher.
- If a student is unable to attend their lesson, please notify both your teacher and the School of Music by email as soon as possible.
- Any lesson canceled with less than 24 hours' notice will be forfeited.
- If your teacher is absent, they will arrange for a school-approved substitute or reschedule the lesson to the semester's makeup week.

PERFORMANCES

- Recitals are scheduled throughout the year. When a student is ready to perform, their private teacher will provide the student/their family a selection of recital dates and times.
- Dress code for recitals: This is a time to celebrate the students' hard work, so please dress appropriately. No sneakers, T-shirts, or jeans.
